Born and highly educated in Europe, Gleyzer burst onto the Atlanta fashion scene when she opened her boutique in the upscale decorative arts plaza in Buckhead, Georgia in 1993. Her knack for infusing color into practicality, uniquely naming each design and use of the most elegant materials categorize her line as "undisputedly chic!"

**Cristina Nitopi** brought her men's line and it is certain to give a new meaning to "putting on your leathers". Red, brown, and even white suits with long coats and vests made a MOD departure from your run of the mill black biker image leather wear.
